



CALL FOR EXPRESSION OF INTEREST TO BE APPOINTED TO THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS TO FILL A MID-TERM VACANCY AS PUBLIC INTEREST DIRECTOR

The Immigration Consultants of Canada Regulatory Council (ICCRC) is a national regulatory body that protects the public by overseeing licensed immigration consulting and international student advising professionals. ICCRC's fulfills its mandate by:

- Establishing entry-to-practice requirements;
- Licensing professionals;
- Overseeing their professional development and conduct;
- Receiving, investigating and adjudicating complaints against its licensed members; and
- Administering a disciplinary process to sanction its licensed members whose professional development and conduct fail to meet ICCRC's standards.

Section 91 of the Immigration and Refugee Protection Act (IRPA) and Section 21.1 of the Citizenship Act require that anyone who provides Canadian immigration or citizenship advice for a fee or other consideration, must be a member in good standing of a law society in Canada, the Chambre des notaires du Québec or ICCRC.
