Runnymede Healthcare Centre (“RHC”) is a dynamic 206-bed rehabilitation and complex continuing care hospital in Toronto’s West end. RHC has been awarded a licence to build a new 200-bed long term care facility on its lands. The Board has approved a new strategic plan to become a Centre of Excellence for Aging and Wellness. The strategic plan includes leveraging the hospital and long term care operations, its new “to be developed” out patient clinic, its partners in the Northwestern Toronto Health Team and digital health solutions to provide integrated care to Toronto’s Northwest population and, in particular, to create a provincial best of class Centre of Excellence for Aging and Wellness.

The board of directors of RHC (the “Board”) is currently comprised of up to 12 elected directors, with four executives of RHC being ex-officio members of the Board. **The Board wishes to fill its vacancies at RHC’s annual meeting on June 25, 2020.**

The Board composition is skills based. The following competencies are being sought to complement the Board’s existing skills and experience:

- Clinical Expertise;
- Digital Health and Analytic;
- Engineering and Architecture;
- Enterprise Risk Management; and
- Legal and Regulatory.
